From the Pastor....

The Past and Future is Now!

Happy New Year Ocker! 2022 is behind us and the future is bright!

I wanted to take this opportunity to thank everybody who helped make 2022 possible here at Ocker.

Ocker is made up of so many talented and devoted volunteers who donate so much of themselves to the kingdom. Throughout the year, so many people come together to create "church"and I wanted to say how thankful I am to each of those people!

Did you know that January takes its name from the old (and of course false) Roman god Janus?

According to the Romans, Janus was a god of beginnings, endings, transitions and

Christians, of course, don't think there is a specific god of time and transition; instead, we believe in the great God who creates, keeps and transcends time. For now...I thought I would close with a "time" concept about God that C.S. Lewis penned. I thought it was interesting and might be relevant to our discussion.

Writer C.S. Lewis compares God's ability to control time to an author's control of time in a book. God doesn't move from page to page, day to day, the way we do. God moves outside of time. For God, there is no yesterday or tomorrow. For God, there is only always now!

If C.S. Lewis is right, then God never says, "I will love tomorrow." Or, "I will help tomorrow." For God, the time to help, grow, love, reflect is now. It is always now. Happy New Year...Here is to 2023, where I pray we can join God in the now!

Operation Christmas Child A Little Piece of Ocker in the World


In November, the church packed 344 boxes for Operation Christmas Child. Each box had a tracking labeled placed so we can see where the boxes ended up in the world. We are excited to announce that a little piece of Ocker was shipped to both Ecuador and Colombia.

Ecuador is located along the west coast of South America. Located right on the equator, Ecuador has a diverse landscape of jungle, mountains, and the wildlife-rich Galápagos Islands. However, Ecuador is a developing country with lots of poverty. Currently, about 40% of children live in poverty within the country. Colombia, Ecuador's large northeastern neighbor, has a mix landscape of forests, savannas, and mountains. Colombia is estimated to have about 20% of the child population living in poverty.

This little country church of ours was able to make an impact on 301 lives. A little piece of Ocker is now in both Ecuador and Colombia helping children in need. **AND WE ARE NOT STOPPING THERE!** This year we will continue to collect items for OCC shoeboxes because we know that God uses this little church to make **BIG DIFFERENCES!**

This January, OCC challenges you to give a little piece of yourself by donating an item each week that best represents you! Crazy for animals, donate toy animals! 
*The collection box is located under the OCC bulletin board in the fellowship hall just before the hallway leading to the Sunday school rooms.
