

Challenger (ages 16 & older): June 11-16. Depart 3:00pm Sunday and return 3:30pm Friday.

Discovery (ages 14-15): June 18-23. Depart 3:00pm Sunday and return 4:00pm Friday.

Pioneer (ages 12-13): June 25-30. Depart 2:00pm Sunday and return 4:00pm Friday.

Encounter (ages 7-9): July 9-12. Depart at 1:00pm Sunday and return 3:00pm Wednesday.

Alpha (ages 10-11) July 16-20. Depart at 3:00pm Sunday and return at 3:00pm Thursday.
