## From the Pastor....

I want to take this opportunity to thank you all for your love and compassion during my Dad's illness and subsequent passing. We had a good three months from his diagnosis and move to my house, to his peaceful passing last week. Ocker allowed me to keep working while caring for my dad at home...thank you! These last three months have been so hard, but I am so glad that we were able to be a safe and loving place for dad to move from this life to his next.

The funeral will be on 9/30 in San Antonio at Trinity Baptist Church @ 2 PM.

These past few weeks, as my dad was getting worse and slowly dying, I have been thinking a lot about forgiveness.

As Christians, we are commanded to forgive and forgive often. But true forgiveness seems to be the one action that is hardest to complete.

Although I don't completely agree with him, Lew B. Smedes has written the most honest and complete book on forgiveness (other than the Bible) entitled, *Forgive and Forget*. In it, he notes that forgiveness is a process one goes through, as opposed to an instant decision. He details four stages of true forgiveness that one must go through:

**Stage 1:** Hurt...when somebody causes you pain so deep and unfair that you cannot forget it, you are pushed into the first stage of the crisis of forgiving...hurt.

**Stage 2:** Hate....you cannot shake the memory of how much you were hurt, and you cannot wish your enemy well. You sometimes want the person who hurt you to suffer as much as you are suffering.

**Stage 3:** Healing....your perspective changes (over time, if you allow it) and you are given the divine ability to see the person who hurt you in a new light. Your memory is healed, you turn back to the flow of pain and are free again.

**Stage 4:** Coming together...you invite the person who healed you back into your life. If he/she comes honestly, you both can move toward a new life and relationship together.

I think Smedes is on to something with these stages of forgiveness....which stage are you in right now? Who sinned against you...and what stage of forgiveness are you in? Are you stuck in hate? Or still at hurt? So many of us can't get out of the first or second stage with so many people we know...and I think that is sad, don't you?

This month, I am going to try to move through some of my stages of forgiveness...would you do the same thing with me?
